The Kiwanis Club of Issaquah will present scholarships to one graduating senior from Issaquah High School, Liberty High School and Tiger Mountain High School. The scholarships will each be a \$1,500.00 cash award to be used to further the student's education and is to be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Applicant will have participated in school and community activities that demonstrate outstanding community service.
- 2. Applicant will have participated in school and community activities that demonstrate outstanding leadership.
- 3. Applicant will have demonstrated academic success.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY: A candidate to be eligible must:

- 1. Be graduating from Issaquah, Liberty or Tiger Mountain High Schools and planning to attend a university, community or technical college.
- 2. Submit a written application for the scholarship on or before April 30.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

- 1. The scholarship award will be made on the basis of community service, leadership activities and academic performance.
- 2. A scholarship Selection Committee composed of members appointed by the Kiwanis Club of Issaquah will choose the applicants to receive each scholarship.
- 3. The successful applicants will be announced by the committee and will receive the scholarship during an appropriate awards ceremony.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

1.	Community Service and Leadership (40%) Using the format provided, attach a list of activities in which you have participated over the past four years that demonstrate outstanding community service and/or leadership. Activities can be school or non-school related. (Examples of community services: stream clean up, volunteer at Food Bank or Senior Center, etc. Examples of leadership: club officer or student body officer, organizer of community service project, captain of athletic team, etc.).
2.	Reference letters (20%)
	Please attach two (2) reference letters (letters of recommendation), from members of the community (not family members) who have supervised you in leadership or community service activities. The letter will attest to the student's (1) commitment to and effort on behalf of community service and/or (2) leadership skills.
3.	Essay (20%)
	In a short essay, (250-300 words) write about the importance of, and your commitment to volunteerism, community service and leadership. Discuss your plans to further your education.
4.	Financial Need (10%)
	What percentage of your college plan is already paid for through college scholarships or other means? What is your family's approximate total income? 0 - \$25,000\$50 - \$75,000\$75,000+
5.	Attach a copy of your transcript (10%)
